Deadline for abstracts: February 12, 2001. Papers will be selected by the ad hoc committee at a meeting in Madrid on March 2, 2001.

The presentations at the congress will be strictly time-limited to 15 minutes with an additional 5 minutes for questions. The deadline for completed papers will be announced later to the successful candidates. Contributors will receive a style guide upon submission of their abstract. This is a simple guide to facilitate the production of your text and graphics according to FITCE standards.
